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### **Community Invited to Celebrate Trinity Apartments**

**Missoula** – Nearly a year has passed since Homeword and Missoula Housing Authority (MHA) completed the Trinity Apartments, one of the state’s largest affordable housing developments. To commemorate these 202 safe, healthy and affordable homes opened in 2023, Homeword and MHA will host a celebration on Tuesday, Aug. 13, from 10-11:30 a.m. at 2200 Mullan Road.

“It’s exciting for us to officially celebrate this accomplishment with our residents, funders, partners and other supporters in our community,” said Homeword Executive Director Karissa Trujillo. “Trinity Apartments has always been about partnership. From the beginning stages of this development, collaboration and partnership were key to addressing the critical need for affordable housing in Missoula.”

Trinity is composed of 172 apartments and rowhomes at Maple Street Flats and Westside Place as well as 30 permanent supportive homes at Blue Heron Place. The newly named Watershed Navigation Center, located adjacent to Blue Heron Place, will open its doors to the community soon.

“Trinity Apartments happened during a critical time for the Missoula community,” said MHA Executive Director Sam Oliver. “On the heels of a global pandemic, the organic partnerships that made Trinity possible provided sorely needed housing for our community’s

families, workforce and underserved neighbors living houseless. We are thrilled to celebrate the success of the entire project with the community it was built to serve.”
